## **Important Information**

- Vendors may set up a table to market art and handmade items created by themselves or family members.
- Sales and Use Tax Permits are required for vendors selling any items, and will be spot checked, so always have a copy of your permit on your table or on your person.
- Food may be sold on the streets with documentation of licensing and health permits which may be obtained from the City of Abilene.
- Non-profit organizations may set up tables to distribute information.
- For-profit businesses not directly related to the arts are not appropriate at this event and are not permitted unless the business is the official sponsor of that ArtWalk.
- Set up is first come, first served, and you must bring your own table and chair(s.)
- If you plan to set up in front of a business that is open that evening, please get permission from that business. (ArtWalk sponsors may reserve space with The Center.)
