



EXHIBITS INFORMATION

All artists wishing to exhibit in solo or group shows at The Center must submit an Exhibit Proposal. The Exhibits Committee meets quarterly to review proposals, and will determine at that time whether to accept, deny or request more information. You may obtain an Exhibit Proposal by emailing the Gallery Manager (gallerymanager@center-arts.com), or download from the Exhibits page at www.center-arts.com.

Member artists are not charged a fee for exhibiting at The Center, as that is a benefit of membership.

Non-member artists who wish to exhibit at The Center for Contemporary Arts may submit an Exhibit Proposal for any gallery other than the Jane Breed (Main) Gallery. If the Exhibits Committee approves the proposal, the artist will be charged a fee of \$120 for marketing, preparation, and hanging, due at the time the Exhibition Agreement is signed.

Should the exhibiting artist submit an application for Artist Membership in The Center within three (3) months of signing an Exhibition Agreement, and be approved for Artist Membership by the Artist Membership Committee, the exhibit preparation fee will be applied toward the first year of the artist's membership dues.

The exhibition preparation fee may also be waived by The Center if the artist secures a sponsor for the proposed exhibit at the level of \$500 or more.

A Sales Tax and Use permit is required to be on file if the Center handles the sale of artwork for any artist. In this event, artists are asked to make a 20% donation of sales to The Center for Contemporary Arts, a 501(c)(3) charity organization, which goes to help support The Center's vital community ArtReach programs, the monthly ArtWalk, and free admission to 30+ contemporary exhibits annually.
